- TERM:** Three years; no more than two consecutive terms.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of the Advisory Board shall be:

- to participate in the planning process and review of procedures used to ensure community involvement, at all stages of the planning process leading to the formulation and adoption of the county alcohol and drug program plans.

- to advise the County Alcohol and Drug Programs Administrator and the Board of Supervisors on policies and goals of the County alcohol and other drug programs and on any other related matters that either party may refer to the Advisory Board, or that are raised by the Advisory Board.

- to encourage and educate the public to understand the nature of alcohol and other drug problems, and encourage support throughout the County for development and implementation of effective programs.

- to review the community's alcohol and other drug program needs, services, facilities, and special programs.

**MEMBERSHIP:** Twenty members. Twelve public members – five of the twelve shall have expertise in alcohol and drug prevention, treatment and recovery services. Eight public service members – will represent their respective service domains and will include representative from child welfare, adult services, health (public or primary care), human assistance and/or criminal justice (police, sheriff and probation).
